# What's the Big 7dea?

Lake Space will leverage the versatility of The Exchange in Camdenton, MO to offer a quiet, collaborative, enthusiastic, and flexible coworking environment for professionals in the area that need reliable access to internet, a private and stylish place to meet, and/or a community of likeminded doers for inspiration.

### WHY COWORKING?

Professionals that leverage a thriving coworking space on a regular basis routinely list the following benefits:

- 1. **Motivation:** There's an energetic accountability in the air when sharing a room.
- 2. **Community:** Members go above and beyond to help one another succeed.
- 3. **Flexibility:** No long-term leases to tie up working capital means that small businesses can leverage their resources in more productive ways.
- 4. **Getting Outside of the Home:** Working from home is great, but it's easy to fall into a rut, too. Being around other people is good for your spirits, it can keep you sharp and is great for creativity.
- 5. **Networking:** When you have so many people with so much in common, it's only a matter of time until you start to network and new opportunities start to flow organically.

### WHY THE EXCHANGE?

Location, layout, and leadership. Situated just steps from the Camden County Courthouse, The Exchange is perfectly located to support all walks of business professionals throughout the Lake area (sales professionals, realtors, small business owners, remote workers, etc). The main hall will serve as our primary coworking space, while the Groom's Lounge and Bridal Loft will be offered up as private meeting rooms. At the helm of this launch plan are Mike and Chelsey Cisar - local natives that built their early careers in the St. Louis Technology Startup scene. They've lived the coworking life within one of the fastest-growing startup economies of the past decade and are leveraging those experiences to create a thriving coworking community.



## Market Demand

We called several business chambers, city/county councils, and private firms to conduct an informal feasibility study and get a sense of what the market demand might be for a coworking space in the area. Turns out... there's A LOT. And people are excited about the potential for Lake Space.

### **Consider This**

- The Lake of The Ozarks region has seen tremendous growth. Economists suspect this trend to continue - with a projected population to cross over 150,000 permanent residents by 2030.
- As more professionals from the KC & STL areas adopt the remote work lifestyle and turn their Lake vacation homes into full-time residences, the demand for flexible work options will only further justify coworking space investments.
- The intersection of Hwy 54 and Hwy 5
  hosts the highest daily traffic volume in
  the tri-county area (as reported by the
  Lake of the Ozarks Regional Economic
  Development Council). Lake Space is
  setting up shop just 1 mile from that
  intersection.

## Market Impact

The <u>2015 Regional Entrepreneurship Assessment & Strategy Report</u> identifies several factors that are impacting growth in the LOTO region. We believe that Lake Space is forming at the perfect time to help.

### **Regional Workforce Challenge**

While the overall population is growing, the region hasn't successfully shown the ability to attract and retain young professionals between the ages of 25 and 44. The lack of young adults could potentially hurt the region's ability to invest in and develop its long-term human capital resources.

### **Attractive Environment**

Coworking spaces like Lake Space provide attractive career development opportunities (networking, collaboration, and accountable environments) for promising young talent.

### **Small-But-Mighty Job Creators**

Small and medium sized businesses are the main job providers and creators in the Lake area. Economic development efforts should be shifted to relevant strategies that focus on helping new businesses start and existing businesses grow.

### The Lake Space DNA

Lake Space is a new business venture that is getting launched by an established business specifically to help small businesses thrive.

### **Entrepreneurial Mis-Conceptions?**

As part of the report, a survey was conducted to assess the public opinion on the region's ability to support entrepreneurs. Respondents want more.
